SEASIDE VILLA experience

This is how the story goes : the Côte de Macre seaside villas appeared in the 19th century, a time when society was changing and architecture, urban planning and artworks captured the coast. Away from the polluted cities, sea resorts were a source of inspiration for wealthy families and architects. The spectacular scenery by the beach is a feast for the eyes: early morning on the embankment, sunlight awakens elegant silhouettes that illuminate the landscape. Let us introduce you to the villas in all shapes and sizes (everything from Neo-Normand to Neo-Gothic) that draw us to them to drink in all their architectural glory. Our heart beats faster at the sight of La Bluette, its soft and smooth curves bringing to mind the wind blowing on the dunes. It looks sweet and wise from a distance. When you get up close, there's always some new detail to spot on the exterior...

Want to know what happens next ? Come and visit the colourful villas and uncover their secrets. Historical landmark, bolthole for writers, foster home for the Emperor's nephew : the villas from Lion-sur-mer to Ouistreham have many a tale to tell.

Top 5 sites to visit to relive the D-Day Landings

1 CAEN MEMORIAL

Travel back in time : the *Caen Memorial* is your ticket to history. This is one **educational and emotional** experience you don't want to miss.



2 GRAND BUNKER

The Grand Bunker is alive with history : six floors stage a faithful reconstruction of the former German command post dating back to June 6th 1944. Explore original equipment essential to the fortification system built by the Germans during World War II at th Atlantic Wall Museum in Ouistreham.



3 PEGASUS BRIDGE

June 6th 1944 was a big day for Pegasus Bridge : the Bénouville bridge was liberated overnight to become the Pegasus Memorial bridge in tribute to the British paratroopers and their winged horse insignia.



HERMANVILLE-SUR-MER MILITARY CEMETERY

Take time out to visit **Hermanville-surmer military cemetery** where a thousand soldiers (British, Canadian, Australian and French) have been laid to rest near Sword Beach.

Follow in the footsteps of soldiers for the weekend...

DAY 1 :

Caen Memorial

With or without a guide, a trip to Caen Memorial is an absolute must: there's the 360° visual projection, awesome testimonial by the reporter Patrick Chauvel, a display about 20th century battles including the infamous Battle of Normandy and more. The museum brings together fascinating yet heart-breaking information and sources to visit (and revisit) the history of an entire nation. An experience for the heart and soul.

DAY 2 : **D-Day Beach tour**

Open a chapter of history on a guided tour starting in Caen: from Pointe du Hoc to Omaha Beach and its cemetery then onto Gold Beach. Normandy's landscapes say more than words and images ever could. Shell holes, shipwrecks, mulberry harbour and more. This is a place that bears the scars of what our forebears experienced.

5 HILLMAN FORTIFIED SITE

Hillman fortified site was built between 1942 and 1944 and is a 24ha open-air **museum** in the great outdoors. Over a dozen bunkers built by the Germans have been **restored** to take you back to this **milestone moment**.

Welcome to Caen Town Hall! As you can see, **you can't judge a book by its cover**. But it's a fabulous cover: this fine example of medieval architecture is still home to Saint-Étienne Church where William the Conqueror rests in peace... **Unmissable !**

5 STREETS ALIVE WITH ART

Our streets are the kind that get a reaction: they're home to street art ! Colours, illustrations, artists... **There are 40-odd temporary artworks to explore** all over Caen la mer. It's an open-air museum !



Fancy a weekend in Caen ?

The next 48 hours are all about getting in some culture and enjoying yourself: let's explore, wander around and make the most of it! What's the plan ? Cover all the must-dos without scratching each other's eyes out !

DAY 1 :

10.11am : Treasure trail at Caen Castle : from the city walls to the bell towers, it's love at first sight !

2.09ph : Old town tour : from the half-timbered houses to Caen stone on countless monuments, the streets are paved with treasures. Our area is famous for its beautiful historical landmarks like Abbaye aux Hommes and Abbaye aux Dames. We take great pride in them! Guess what ? Our Tourist Office provides free trails lasting 2-3 hours so you don't miss a bit of our rich heritage !

4.27 *p***m** : **Shopping in central Caen** : bookshop, record shop, craft shops, bag shop, jewellery, milliner... You won't know where to look next.

6.59 pm : Happy hour on the marina : oh we do like to be beside the seaside !

DAY 2 :

10.08ah: **It's market day**: everyone knows that Saint-Pierre market is the place to be on Sunday morning. It's the last day of the weekend so grab your bag and stock up for the week. There's something for everyone on the market stalls: fresh and tasty !

12.48pm : Foodie break in the Vaugueux district : sample the best of our local produce ! Get a warm welcome from our restaurants : cider, cheese, tripe, seafood, desserts in all their glory. Our chefs know how to make your mouth water.

4.34pm : Bye, Bye Normandy : Already leaving ? But you've not even said goodbye to the sea, sand and fish... There's no way you can go without having one last dip ! Go on... Just a toe... Plus the beach is only 15 minutes away. It would be a shame to miss out !

 > Steam in a steam oven (50°C) for 15 minutes


Step 2 : Asparagus time

Cook asparagus tips in very little water
Put the lid on to lock in their crunch
Use your choice of seasonal vegetables

Step 3 : Chorizo-a-go-go
Finely dice ¼ of extra spicy chorizot
Soften chorizo in a pan
Add one quartered tomato
Add 200ml of cream
Season and bring to the boil
Blend and strain
Add half a spoon of soya lecithin

Step 4 : Dress to impress

Step 5 : Forks at the ready !




