

From Caen to Ouistreham





TIP

The 12express bus from the Riva Centre stop towards Gare SNCF (Caen) will drop you off in the city centre at the Tour Leroy stop.

Please note that only folding bikes are allowed on board.

- Opposite the port, turn left along the Ouai de la Londe.
- Follow the harbour for 350m. Do not cross the bridge, turn left onto Avenue de Tourville. This is the start of the Vélofrancette cycle path.
- After 1.5km, the road disappears, leaving only the cycle path. Continue on the towpath along the canal for 12km. Along the way, you will not want to miss the famous Pegasus Bridge.
- When you reach the port of Ouistreham, continue along the cycle path that runs alongside the port for 1.3km.
- Cross the ferry access roads on the cycle path and go round to the left.
- Go past the car park and turn right to pass under the trees. Continue along the cycle path.
- Continue as far as the tourist office, which is where you arrive.

Start / Finish: Parking des joyeux coureurs - Route de Louvigny 14000 Caen



- From the car park, walk to the Orne and take the path on your right. Take a small wooden footbridge and then a path under tall poplars for 1km.
- At the junction, turn left and continue for 1.1km.
- At the crossroads, take the black asphalt track ahead for 300m.
- Continue straight ahead, leaving the asphalt track to take a pink sand path for 450m.
- Go up the stairs on your left. Once at the top, go right for 200m.
- Cross the road and continue along the path for 650m.
- At the junction, continue straight on for 100m.
- Take the wooden ramp on the right to return to the car park.

TIP

Discover the Enchanted Island Bridge! Turn left for around a hundred metres at point number 3 and discover this famous red bridge where the old railway used to run.

The Vélo Francette and Vélomaritime







- The Vélo Francette is a cycle route linking Ouistreham (in Normandy) to La Rochelle (in Nouvelle-Aquitaine).
 - > From Ouistreham to Caen, the route takes you along the greenway that runs alongside the Caen canal. The route is 17.5 km long.
 - > Once in Caen, the route continues along the voie verte and descends towards Suisse Normande. Caen is 27 km from Le Hom, near Thury-Harcourt.



From Roscoff in Brittany to Dunkirk on the Belgian border, this cycle route passes through legendary sites such as Mont-Saint-Michel and its bay, the D-Day landing beaches and the cliffs of Etretat. With a large proportion of shared roads, it's an ideal cycling route for cyclists looking for an escape, a challenge, as well as cultural and gastronomic discoveries.




Park your bike





Where can I park my bike in Caen?



There are four cycle shelters with a total of 48 spaces in four locations in Caen city centre: place Courtonne, place Saint-Jean, behind the nautical stadium (rue Jean de la Varende) and near the SNCF station (rue Pierre-Mendès France, on the Parcotrain side).

The city of Caen has also installed 82 parking spaces in the form of cycle hoops and six bicycle inflating stations in the 6 underground car parks in the city centre. The underground car park at the Rives de l'Orne shopping centre also has an inflation station.

There are also cycle racks where you can secure your bike with an anti-theft device. They are located at the château, place de la République, the town hall, place Gardin, the Paul-Doumer centre (Fnac) and place de la Résistance.

- The location of the bike racks is indicated on the map of Caen by small circles.

The nearest water point is in the toilets behind the swimming pool.

Safety information





ROAD SAFETY

Respect the Highway Code, to which all cyclists are also subjected. In the event of a serious offence, you could be fined.

Wearing a helmet is compulsory for children under 12s, but we recommend it for everyone. A yellow safety jacket and full lighting are compulsory when riding at night or on overcast days.

Generally,

- On green lanes, give way to pedestrians and signal your arrival by ringing your bell
- On shared roads, make sure you signal your intentions: hold out your arm when turning, position yourself appropriately on the carriageway. Watch out for blind spots and lateral movements of vehicles.







Located close to the Vélomaritime, the stopover cabins are on a site comprising 2 cabins.

Ideal for cyclists or hikers, the accommodation is a mix between a chalet and a tent, and includes a sleeping area of around 5 m^2 with 2 beds (2 bed base of 80 x 190cm with a mattress protected by a sheet), an electric socket and a terrace with an awning equipped with 2 chairs and a table.

A single-use mattress protection is provided for each bed, along with a cleaning kit. A space in front of the cabin is available for bicycles.



Access to the site and communal facilities is by key code only, which will be given to you a few days before your arrival. On site, you will find a building comprising a self-catering room with a sink, a small fridge, a microwave oven, a cleaning kit (broom, dustpan, bucket), a table and 4 chairs, as well as a bathroom area with 1 shower, 1 toilet and a washbasin with mirror.

A bicycle repair kit (small tools) as well as practical and tourist information are available.



Public transports:





- BUSES AND TRAMS <u>twisto</u> IN CAEN LA MER Bikes are permitted on trams. On buses, only folding bicycles are allowed.
- ▼ REGIONAL NOMA D TRANSPORT Bicycles are accepted in the hold provided there is enough room (luggage have priority!).

Line 39 between Caen/Honfleur/Le Havre offers a "bike rack" service, enabling you to attach your bike to the back of the bus. This service is free and can be booked the day before by calling 09 70 83 00 14.

THE « SNCF » TRAINS

You can travel with your dismantled bike on all trains at no extra charge and without booking. To do so, it must be transported in a cover (size 120x90 cm). You can carry your unassembled bike as long as there is space available. On other trains (Intercités, TGV), you must transport it in dedicated spaces. Check the timetables and look out for the pictogram.
